The new park features canopies for shade as well as seating areas. Water fountains for dogs, equipped with stationary drinking bowls, are also available at the park. The City of Fremont contributed funding for enhancements to the park.

Completion of the new park fulfills BART's commitment to build and open the new facility before it closed the old park.
